 - A dedicated helpdesk or counseling cell is set up to assist students with the application process, ensuring they have all the necessary documents and meet the eligibility requirements.
 - Faculty members and administrative staff provide personalized guidance and support to applicants.
- 4. Collaboration with Local Authorities:
 - The college collaborates with local government authorities and schools to promote the Kanyashree Programme in the region.
 - Joint initiatives and outreach programs are conducted to maximize the reach and impact of the scholarship scheme.
- 5. Incentives and Recognition:
 - The college recognizes and rewards students who successfully receive the Kanyashree Scholarship, motivating other eligible students to apply.
 - Success stories and testimonials of Kanyashree beneficiaries are shared to inspire and encourage others.
- 6. Regular Monitoring and Follow-up:
 - The college maintains a record of all students who have applied for and received the Kanyashree Scholarship.
 - Regular follow-ups are conducted to ensure that beneficiaries continue their education and utilize the scholarship effectively.

These measures have significantly contributed to increasing awareness and participation in the Kanyashree Scholarship Programme, helping more girls to pursue higher education and achieve their academic goals.
