
Myths and misconceptions about leprosy, perpetuated by cultural beliefs and misinformation, influence attitudes towards people affected by the disease.

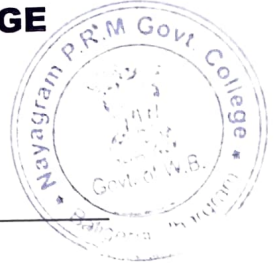
